The service area in Victory Park promises to provide multiple opportunities for NCYC participants to join the team "**Service Saints.**" This interactive venue will help you grow in faith and deepen your understanding of Catholic social teaching while discovering ways to help others. Every service project at NCYC you can do at home...we'll show you how! Each service area needs your assistance in providing items to distribute to those in need and contribute to the different charities that will benefit from the service projects. Please find your region below for the items your area is asked to donate. Please be as generous as you can with your donations.

The anchor project of our service area is a water purification system and well. Each participant is challenged to give up the cost of beverage during the conference and donate the amount to the "Waters of Baptism" water tank. So if one of your drinks is \$2.00 that is what you are asked to donate to the tank. You can watch throughout the conference as the giant water tank FILLS UP in the "Waters of Baptism" venue in the service area. Money donated goes to building purification systems and wells for Haiti.

Regions 1 & 12: Hairbrushes, combs, toothpaste, toothbrushes

Region 2: Journals for kids to write in

Region 3: Single or double pack of toilet paper

Region 4: Children's books

Region 5: School notebook paper, pencils, pens

Region 6: Canned fruits or vegetables

Region 7: Crackers, cereal, or Hamburger Helper

Region 8: Canned tuna or stew

Region 9: Rice, spaghetti, or mac-n-cheese

Regions 10 & 11: Bars of soap, shampoo, conditioner

Region 13: Fiction and non-fiction books for adults

Region 14: Bags of rice and/or beans (any type)
